

#### **Advancement of Work**


- Demolition: 90% complete

- MEP Coordination: Underground and lower level is complete.





# **Air Quality Monitoring**

In compliance with our Dust Control Plans, we monitor for two things: Dust &Naturally Occurring Asbestos (NOA)

Dust reports are issued weekly. NOA reports are issued daily.

BAAQMD inspect the site daily to confirm compliance.

If there is a detection above an "action level," we have to investigate and mitigate the cause.



# **Air Quality Monitoring**

For NOA, if there are two days in a row with detection levels above the action level, we have to halt work.

The action level for NOA is based on an increased risk for asbestos cancers of one in ten thousand if exposed continuously for a period of 70 years.

# **NOA Monitoring Results**

- Elevated readings on 3/9 and 3/10 likely correspond to demo of a retaining wall immediately adjacent to the monitor.
- Elevated readings on 3/23 and 3/27 were on downslope away from residences and likely due to excavating a stockpile of soil immediately adjacent to the monitor.
- Elevated reading on 3/28 was likely related to a stalled truck immediately adjacent to the monitor on the corner of 25<sup>th</sup> and Connecticut






